Brief Description: Population aging is a global phenomenon of increasing importance, yet it is likely to have diverse implications across different national and cultural settings. Despite this, few volumes have examined intimate, personal, and social relationships among the older population from a global perspective. Indeed, gerontological relationship theories are based almost entirely on research from the U.S. and Western Europe. The *Cambridge Handbook of Relationships in Later Life* will address this gap in the published literature. This volume will provide contemporary theory and research concerning relationships and aging globally. This includes a variety of diverse contexts, both within and beyond “WEIRD” samples and countries. For instance, this volume will explore romantic relationships among older adults in Brazil, intergenerational relationships in Korea, and caregiving relationships in rural South Africa. This book will also include chapters on broad themes concerning aging and relationships globally, such as LGBTQIA+ lives, kinlessness and friendship, global aging in digital world, and relationships among the oldest-old. Overall, the primary contribution of this volume will be its international focus, as well as its interest in minority groups both within and beyond U.S. and European settings.
